Job Description:

Guide program participants to develop and maintain the Life skills necessary to obtain their goals. Provide guidance, or referrals as needed. Assist in follow up case management check in. Conduct house meetings. Assure security of residents and property. Responsible to respond to any disturbance and prevent loitering in or around mission properties. Ensure campus is safe and secure. Perform hourly rounds of the property. Maintain department records. Develop reporting system/practices to ensure security issues are documented and reported as appropriate. Ensure that documentation is maintained properly for residents and guests. Ensure all emergencies and incidents are logged and reported to appropriate staff.

Requirements:

High School diploma or GED preferred; minimum of (1) year experience in related field, or as a Disciple at the Mission; Class C license recommended; DMV printout / clean driving record; communicate effectively with co-workers, and the general public; demonstrate a Christ-like behavior and attitude in all duties and responsibilities; perform all job functions per the employer's expectations and comply with all conditions, terms of employment.
