Requirements:

BA, MA or other degree in Christian Ministries, Counseling, Social Services, Organizational Leadership or related area (relevant working experience will also be considered as a replacement for education). A minimum of five years of ministry experience and involvement in the local church; be able to communicate effectively and professionally with Mission staff and the general public; demonstrate Christ-like behavior and attitude in all duties and responsibilities, perform all job functions per the CMO and Executive Staff expectations and comply with conditions, terms of employment.

Fresno Mission Statement of Faith

1. We believe the Bible to be the inspired, the only infallible, authoritative word of God.
2. We believe that there is one God, externally existent in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
3. We believe in the deity and humanity of Christ, in His virgin birth, His sinless life, His miracles, His vicarious and atoning death through His shed blood, His bodily resurrection, His ascension to the right hand of the Father, His present rule as Head of the Church, and His personal return in power and glory.
4. We believe that for the salvation of lost and sinful people regeneration by the Holy Spirit is absolutely essential.
5. We believe in the present ministry of the Holy Spirit, by whose indwelling the Christian is enabled to live a Godly life.
6. We believe in the resurrection of both the saved and the lost, that they are saved to the resurrection of life or they are lost to the resurrection of damnation.
