Job Description:

Your primary responsibility would entail cooking daily meals exceeding over 399, in addition to the practical knowledge of cooking, prepping, sanitation and safety required for the position as part of food service you may be asked to complete the following:

- Transporting meals on a daily basis
Our downtown campus produces the large quantity of meals that we delivery to our sister campus and local shelter.
- Possess patience- as part of the discipleship program we work alongside those disciples in program. Training them with kitchen skills and work ethics while they gain hours to support their certifications.
- Catering meals or events onsite or offsite
Responsibilities may vary depending on location, supply needs, and menu expectations.
- Warehouse – sorting, rotating, assist in various daily required operational needs.
